FIND/PI supports parents reach their full potential by offering 3 types of services:

All services are free

- **Home Visits:** Parents Educators visits families in their home twice a month for 60-90 minutes. Using the Parents as Teachers curriculum they facilitate fun parent-child activities, provide developmental information and partner with parents to enhance their overall family well-being.
- **Play Groups (*Group Connections*):** All program sites provide at least two weekly times 90 minute times that are dedicated to open ended art, socialization, stories and play time. Groups are open to the entire community.
- **Workshops:** FIND/PI invites guest speakers, community agencies and parent educators to come speak on topics chosen through parent interests.



Learning Starts Early:



Babies begin learning before they are even born!

FIND/PI partners with parents in to help children reach their maximum potential by supporting:

- **healthy parent/child relationships and attachment**
 - **developing fine motor skills (strengthening little fingers)**
- **gross motor skills—sitting, crawling, walking, running and jumping**
- **Language development (talking and listening!)**
- **Problem solving skills**
- **Healthy social emotional development (sharing and making friends)**
